



What does a Coffee Host do?

The coffee host volunteers to provide refreshments for the hospitality time following each service. One person is scheduled for the 8 am hospitality time and three persons are scheduled for the 10:30 am hospitality time.

Coffee hosts are assigned on a rotation basis. The coffee hosts are asked to provide the following:

- A) juice and/or some type of drink
- B) cake or cookies
- C) a light appetizer of their choice

The church provides the following:

- A) coffee
- B) paper products and utensils
- C) serving trays and bowls.

The coffee hosts should plan on arriving about 15 minutes prior to the service to make coffee and prepare their food and drink for hospitality time. They may wish to leave after communion to go to the parish hall and prepare their refreshments for serving.

The coffee hosts will need to stay till the end of the hospitality time to clean up. We ask that all coffee pots are emptied and washed and that all serving items are washed and put away. We also ask that all trash be collected, bagged and put in the dumpster.

We remind all our coffee hosts that this is not meant to be breakfast or lunch. Hospitality time is meant to be a time for fellowship and to welcome our visitors.

Several times during the year we have special receptions and dinners. During these times we ask for volunteers to help with food, setting up, decorating, and cleaning up.
