(Lay Readers)

A Worship Leader, also known as a Lay Reader, is licensed to lead public worship and to read the sermon or homily under the direction of a member of the clergy in charge of the Congregation. In the Diocese of Mississippi, the person shall be trained, examined, and found competent in several subjects. There are several books available to help with the study. At St. Peter's, the Lay Reader reads the first lesson, leads the psalm and administers the Chalice at communion. A Lay Reader may also lead other services as needed.

LAY EUCHARISTIC MINISTER

(Chalice Bearer)

Lay Eucharistic Ministers, also known as Chalice Bearers, are lay persons licensed by the bishop to administer the chalice at the eucharist. Chalice bearers usually vest for the service and process in with the altar party.

Training is available for anyone interested in becoming a Lay Eucharistic Minister.
